

Elimination of the desire to commit crime. This is the most complex aspect of crime prevention. The reasons people commit crimes are deeply rooted in the social and economic conditions: values, housing, education, health care opportunities. Some people commit crimes for the thrills. Others, for gain. Still others, out of compulsion. Motivation is hard to pinpoint. Yet, it is important to understand the forces that produce hostility and alienation enough to lead someone to beat up an old woman or vandalize a neighborhood store. It is usually left to government and private agencies to deal with these complexities. But there are citizens efforts that can help restore a sense of community and moral values.

All four forms of crime prevention are proactive. That is, they try to deal with crime before it happens. In this sense, the notion of crime prevention runs counter to the reactive mode in which the criminal justice system functions. Police, prosecutors and corrections officers are all geared to respond after the fact. Crime prevention tries to keep that "fact" from coming into being.

New Pimmit Hills Directory



Mr. Chuck Ouellette is volunteering his time and services for the Pimmit Hills Fall Clean-Up. In return he asks that we observe certain procedures listed below.

Brush/limbs should be placed at the curbside with "butt" ends all facing the street.

Try to keep piles of brush/limbs to "1-man piles". (A pile that 1 man can pick up.)

No stumps. Branches can go up to 16" in diameter. Lumber is okay if it is free of nails or other metal.

No wires or foreign debris. No metal, hinges or nails.

Mr. Ouellette will be the only tree/brush pickup for the Fall Clean-Up. Remember. He is volunteering his services. I'm sure we'll remember him in the future when one of us needs tree work done. Reduction of opportunities to commit crime. Many crimes are not planned. They wouldn't occur at all if not for the opportunity. Victims - because of neglect or ignorance - are often unwitting accessories to crimes. Awareness of security and self-protection helps to reduce crime opportunities.

Incapacitation of those who commit crimes.
This is the responsibility of the criminal justice system - police, prosecutors, courts and correction agencies. But it can't perform unless citizens help.
Police are the gateway to the criminal justice system. They catch criminals and try to keep them out of circulation by providing sound evidence for prosecution. But police depend on people's willingness to report crime and give information. So do prosecutors.

Not all offenders are kept out of circulation. The system must be selective about who it incapacitates, especially in times of shrinking resources. The number of criminals seems to be growing. But, there aren't enough police to catch criminals. Not enough courts to try those who are caught. Not enough jails to hold those who are convicted. Yet the public demands longer and stiffer sentences. The answer is to concentrate on the few active criminals who commit most of the crimes.

NEIGHBORHOOD WATCH UPDATE

The following information is from the Neighborhood Watch Newsletter published by the Fairfax County Police Department.

WHAT IS CRIME PREVENTION?

Crime prevention is: being aware that a crime can occur: anticipating its form, location, time and victim: and taking some action to reduce its chance of happening.

Crime prevention takes four forms:

- · Interruption of a crime in progress
- Reduction of opportunities to commit crimes
- Incapacitation of those who commit crimes
- Elimination of the desire to commit crimes

Interruption of a crime in progress. A crime in progress may be stopped by its victim (e.g., coming upon an intruder on his property), a Good Samaritan (e.g., seeing a mugger on the streets), or police (e.g., arriving at a crime scene). Sometimes crimes can be stopped by diverting them to police decoys whose job it is to attract criminal acts.

Unfortunately, crimes in progress are interrupted only rarely. To do so means stumbling on a crime scene. But stumbling can be dangerous. It's best not to take matters into one's own hands. A call to the police or a shouted warning to the assailant can be the wisest course.
