NEIGHBORHOOD WATCH UPDATE

The following information is from the Neighborhood Watch Newsletter published by the Fairfax County Police Department.

WHO ARE THE CRIMINALS?

There are a number of popular stereotypes of criminals - like those you've seen on television. But the television stereotypes are only sometimes true. If a criminal is defined as someone who breaks the law, then almost everyone is a criminal. Most people break the law at some time or other. But there are some laws - the ones dealing with murder, stealing etc. - that are held more sacred than others. The ones who break these laws are considered criminals. They also happen to be the ones most visible.

The street criminal, violent criminal, are the ones who often end up in jail. They tell most of what we know about criminals:

Criminals tend to be young - aged 16 to 30. Beyond those ages they just seem to straighten out on their own. They also tend to be male.

Criminals tend to commit many crimes during their careers. One study showed that 8% of one prison's population committed 60% of that state's crime.

Criminals tend to commit many types of crimes in their careers. There are few specialists among prison inmates. Many evolve from petty vandals to sophisticated felons.
