Long time Pimmit Hills resident is remembered



hirley Johanna Barnes, one of the first residents of Pimmit Hills, passed away on July 3 of this year.

Shirley was born on April 29, 1928 in Pleasantville, New Jersey. She grew up on the beaches of Atlantic City until her family moved to Washington, DC when she was nine. Shirley graduated from Central High School in DC and focused her artistic talents at Columbia Technical Institute. There, she met her husband John Barnes (Jack) of fifty-two years.

Shirley and Jack were among the first residents of Pimmit Hills in the early 1950s, and they raised their four children here, Jan, Christine, Jacqueline and Thomas. Shirley mothered many more: as the "neighborhood mom" who ran daily summer morning activities for the children of the block, a school crossing guard for Fairfax County police in Pimmit Hills, a secretary for Lemon Road Elementary School, president of the Marshall PTA, Den Mother, parent supporter in all of her children's sports activities, and lastly, teaching Sunday School.

As an artist, Shirley actively demonstrated her talents in painting, drawing and needlework. Being a community and political activist, she agreed to volunteer whenever asked. Shirley served as the secretary of the Pimmit Hills Citizens Association and also volunteered at the Pimmit Hills Senior Center. She was very involved in politics, would have meetings at her house, and you could always see her at the school on election day.

Shirley was a leader. Always having a wonderful sense of humor, she displayed a caring nature for all mankind. She will be missed in our community.

"If dreams ever do come true, this is one for me," Diana said.

She has finished six other manuscripts, but this novel is the first to find a publisher. Diana has had several book signing engagements in the area and she and her book were featured in an article in the Alexandria Gazette.

The article stated that her novel is

about the Hamiltons, a Southern family that defies convention by not only freeing slaves, but by making a former slave a business partner in the family's business.

Their beliefs put them at odds with popular sentiment, as they deal with local raids and Union army forces. But they persevere in their dreams and determination and eventually emerge triumphant.

"History is my passion, but historical accuracy was my commitment," Diana said of the making of her novel. She is very interested in Southern history, especially the Civil War.

Diana moved to Pimmit Hills with her family when she was

seven years old. She grew up on Hileman Road, and in 1970, she and her first huband (now deceased) bought her present house on Gilson Street. She and later her daughter attended Lemon Road Elementary and Marshall High School.

For 32 years, Diana has worked in municipal purchasing, but she has always loved to write. Now that her children are grown, she is pursuing her dream to work on her novels.
