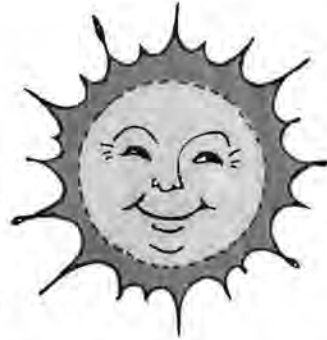

these folks know. No experience is necessary for some of the available positions, just a willingness to pitch in and serve your community.

Changing the PHCA Meeting Time: A request was made to consider changing the regular meeting time of the Association from the first Tuesday of every month to the second Tuesday. This proposal will be discussed at the March meeting, so don't miss it!

Finally, there was a discussion of what to do with the information that Douglas Hansen, of Fairfax County's Office of Transportation, shared with us at the January meeting. It was decided that the Association would send a letter

requesting a study be made of key intersections to see which would be eligible for the Traffic Calming Program. This is just the first step in the process to take some action to make our neighborhood roads safer for all of us. Community participation and approval is a requirement for this program, so keep an eye out for future updates and requests for your input.

The Pimmit Hills Gardener

Real red tomatoes, crunchy-sweet corn on the cob, and zillions of zucchini! If you dream of a vegetable garden to rival the supermarket produce section or just a small patch for a couple of tomato plants, preparation and timing can make the difference between a great harvest and a plot full of weeds.

Preparation begins with the soil, and the first step is to add lots of organic matter. This can be compost, rotting leaves, old, broken-down mulch, rotted manure, or whatever's on hand. Using a shovel or digging fork, turn the material under with a scattering of lawn or garden fertilizer to feed the little microbes that are doing the decomposing.

For large, individual plants such as tomatoes and peppers, I like to top the soil with another layer of organic matter. Later, as summer approaches, top this with a thick layer of newspaper (a dozen sheets, give or take), then wood chips or grass clippings to hold the paper in place. This extra organic material and mulching will keep your veggies happy and reduce your summer watering.

The timing of your planting all depends on what you are growing.

If you want peas, greens, cole crops (cabbage, broccoli, etc.), or root crops, you will have to plant these early -- by early April, at the latest. Warm season crops such as tomatoes, peppers, beans, squash and melons should wait until the weather is good and warm, usually the end of April at the earliest.

Set your warm season veggies between the rows of cool season veggies -- by the time the tomato plants get big the peas and



radishes are done. And plant successively. Quick maturing bush beans can be planted in short rows every 2 to 3

weeks through June and cool season peas and lettuce can be sown again towards the end of the summer.

Also, be adventurous! Try something different! There's red okra, seedless watermelon, rainbow-colored Swiss chard, miniature carrots, and even a golden beet! Call me when dinner's ready! ☞

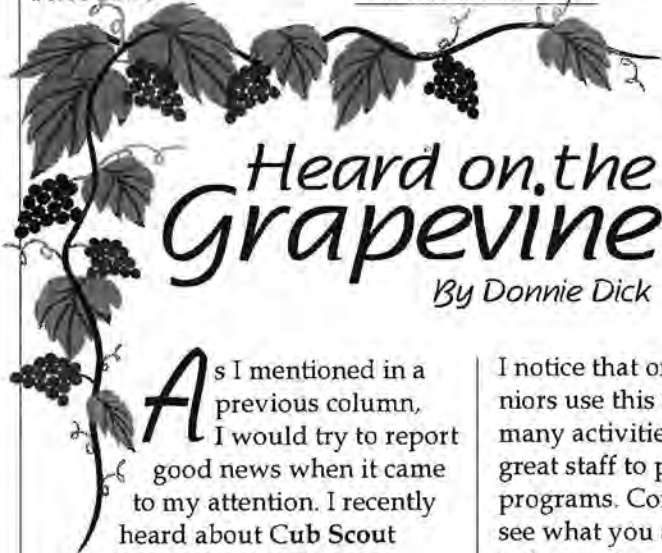
