



address the complaint.

Watch out for phone scams! At the meeting, a resident pointed out that unscrupulous people are using the phone to pitch a variety of things that may seem ok on the surface, but are really designed to part us from our money. Residents are encouraged to be very cautious and never give out their credit card or other financial information over the phone, unless they have initiated the contact. Also beware of salesmen who come to your door. Springtime brings out folks trying to sell home-related services, so it's always good to keep in mind the old adage that if a deal seems to good to be true, it probably is.

Jeff Rose gave the final report on the Traffic Calming Project. He con-

firmed that we did indeed miss the 75% level of support that was needed in order for the process to be continued and a community task force formed. 52% of those petitioned were in favor of the process continuing, 7% were against and 41% did not respond (this particular percentage is primarily made up of people who we were unable to reach despite repeated attempts). So it's official, traffic calming will not be considered for Pimmit Hills. Many thanks go to all of those who participated in this project. Kudos on a good effort by all involved!

I hope these monthly highlights serve as an appetizer that make you want to come out for the "meal" itself. See you in May! ca

Also across the river is the National Cathedral with its retail greenhouse and gardens and an annual "Flower Mart" (the first Friday and Saturday in May).

There are a number of historic houses with notable gardens, among them **Dunbarton Oaks** designed by Beatrix Ferrand, the Hillwood Museum Gardens planted by Marjorie Merriweather-Post, Mount Vernon landscaped with historic plant varieties that still entice the gardener, and River Farm, head-quarters of the American Horticultural Society, just below Alexandria.

A little farther away is Brookside Gardens, part of the Wheaton Regional Park, just east of Georgia Avenue in Maryland. This place has a beautifully landscaped conservatory, a lake, ponds and fountains, a children's garden, numerous formal gardens, and a wooded hillside full of unusual trees and shrubs.

A little closer to home visit Meadowlark Gardens on Beulah Road between Route 7 and the Dulles Toll Road. Having recently fenced-out the hungry deer, the gardens are finally filling out.

Green Spring Garden Park just off Little River Turnpike near Braddock Road is one of the best kept secrets of the Fairfax County Park System. These gardens are innovative, informative and beautifully designed. The horticulture center offers a well-endowed library,



scads of free leaflets and plant lists, and it also hosts many gardening events, including their own winter lecture series. One of the best plant sales around is held at Green Spring twice a year: the third Saturday in May and again in September. (Bring the big car to this one!)

And there are plenty of gardeners in Pimmit Hills. Wondering about the identity of your neighbor's yellow-flowered vine or that purplish spiky thing in the pot? Just ask! Gardeners are nice people and always happy to answer questions (at least 99.9% of the time). So, if you're wondering, just holler and I'll be happy to take a break and tell you — that is a yellow form of our native Honeysuckle Vine and the other is a purple-leaf New Zealand Flax.cs





his month I am reflecting on national issues impacting on our local area. I would swear that Jimmy Carter was back in the White House and not George W. Bush.

First we have the stock market going into the dumpster, layoffs in the high-tech sector, bankrupt utilities in California, fuel shortages, and then higher taxes at the County level and creeping price increases across the board. It sounds like stagflation all over again.

Let's see, my gas company just informed me that my natural gas price would increase from 32.9 cents per therm to 75.9 cents per therm starting in April. The Washington Post price went up in March and trash pickup increased their rates. The cable company no longer provides a program guide, but the price remains the same.
